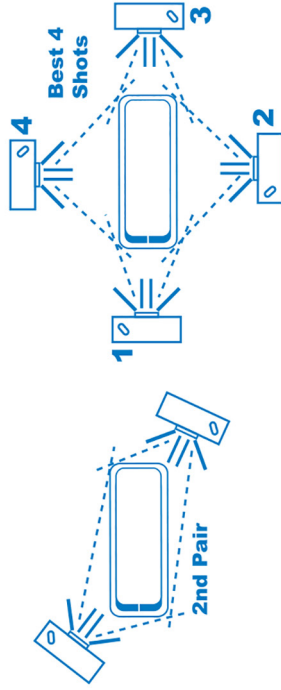

Your Photographic Evidence Is Critical

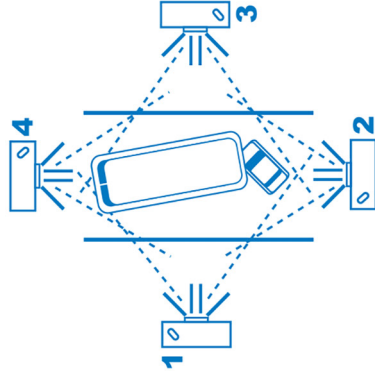
- Take photographs as quickly as possible, before vehicles are moved, if safe to do so.
- Take pictures of all damaged vehicles and the scene, each from all 4 sides.
- Photograph all tire marks and debris in the road.
- Take shots of all signs and traffic control devices.
- Take photos of anything that may have caused an obstruction of view (i.e., bushes, trees, parked cars).
- Photograph any pavement defects (i.e., potholes, faded paint).
- Do not take pictures of injured parties.
- Note date, time, place and name of person taking photos.

Please do not process or mail film, email photos or delete photos from your device until you have received instructions from a Nobel claim representative.

Photograph ALL vehicles from all 4 sides



Photograph the accident scene from all 4 sides



Sequence: As the driver saw the situation

- Regular intervals
- At driver height
- In line
- Consider view obstruction
